Except for the weather, it's been quiet up here this year. But we had lots of rain, mudslides, and washouts !! With the Mowich and Evans Creek areas being so heavily logged, we're getting lots of blow downs from the southeast winds that now blast through the Upper Carbon.

The Ipsuit ( Carbon ) entrance to Mt. Rainier Nat. Park will probably not be open for vehicles this year, or Ever. Many roads and trails washed out, but the trail to the glacier will be open with the detour on the James Lake trail. the Mowich entrance to the Park will probably not open until July 3rd.

They had meetings in Wilkeson to get input as to desired use, then they surveyed Fairfax Township to assess the land and waters for future public use. Eventually they'll both be open to the public. The Carbon River Ranch will be taken over by the National Park in the future and will probably be their ranger station.
